The Events Market is written in Ruby on Rails. You will implement sophisticated yet pragmatic additions to the XING platform with a good test coverage. We do not work alone, but we collaborate with other development teams at XING, connecting our apps using REST and AMQP. We are all full stack developers, and as part of the team you will build complete features from end to end. At XING, we use Github Enterprise to manage our code base. We heavily use open source projects, and contribute back regularly (see also <https://github.com/xing>).

- Sound understanding of algorithms, data structures and general software development patterns as well as API experience with HTTP, REST, and JSON.
- Deep understanding of Ruby on Rails, and the Ruby language.

- Good understanding of the web's frontend technologies, meaning HTML, CSS, and JavaScript, especially React.
- Good understanding of database technologies.
- Be able and willing to coach other developers.
